The book's travel guide format instills the reader with a feeling of adventure as the author describes the physical layout of heaven and addresses questions such as:

- Will we be able to recognize friends and loved ones?
- Will there be animals and pets there?
- How will we fill our time?
- Doesn't eternity ever get boring?

As DeStefano answers these and many more questions, he demolishes the idea that heaven is a vague haze of a sweet but boring afterlife. Instead, it is a physical place that can be compared to a five-star luxury resort. The residents are real, their bodies transformed into their most perfect selves—physically, emotionally, and spiritually. By making a spiritual subject immensely physical, the book provides a picture of amazing places to visit, things to do, luxuries for pampering—not to mention deep, abiding joy. It is more beautiful than a Hawaiian sunset, more thrilling than Alpine skiing, more fun than any amusement park ride, and more riveting than the best novel. Combining great clarity with logic and the adventure of a travel guide, DeStefano creates a brilliant and reassuring portrait of heaven, a place that has intrigued and puzzled humankind throughout history.
